What is Catherine Cares?



Uplifting families of babies facing life-threatening diagnoses

Catherine Cares uplifts families of babies who receive a life-threatening diagnosis by providing Heartbeat Bears as well as restaurant and fuel gift cards. The services are gifted to hospital partners throughout the United States. Our hospital partners distribute the services to families at or around the time of a prenatal or newborn diagnosis. Catherine Cares is a St. Louis-based nonprofit providing services throughout the United States. Catherine Cares is fully tax deductible under IRS code section 501(c)(3).

Catherine Cares began providing Heartbeat Bears to hospitals in February 2017. The Heartbeat Bears come with recording devices. When a baby receives a prenatal or newborn life-threatening diagnosis, our hospital partners record the baby's heartbeat, place the device in the pocket of the bear and present the bear to the family. The Heartbeat Bears provide comfort for grieving families as well as an opportunity for families to talk about their babies in a kid-friendly, healthy manner.



Catherine Cares was founded by Wayne & Lauren Turley while Lauren was pregnant with the couple's second daughter, Catherine Marie. As a result of Lauren's 20-week ultrasound, Catherine was diagnosed with Trisomy-18 and given a short life expectancy. The Turleys were heartbroken. Catherine was born on December 30, 2014, and lived for an hour. Catherine Cares is her legacy.

The purpose of *Bucks for Bears* is to showcase your school's caring H.E.A.R.T. by raising funds to provide Heartbeat Bears to *Catherine Cares* families in your community.

How to Implement Bucks for Bears:

- 7. Optional: Apply for our *Bucks for Bears* grant online.



How to Implement Bucks for Bears?

1. Work with your student leadership team to educate them on the purpose and mission of the *Bucks for Bears* program.

Work with student leaders to determine the type of fundraising event(s) as well as time frame that works for your school. We recommend a simple, easy to implement plan. For example:

- ♥ Pay to bring your favorite stuffed animal to school for a day
- A week-long challenge between classes or grades

4. Educate Parents and Staff on the mission of Catherine Cares & Bucks for Bears.

Educating Parents and Staff on Catherine Cares, Bucks for Bears and your fundraising event before implementation helps to insure success.

We have several resources online to help educate both Parents & Staff:

- ▼ An electronic & customizable letter template to send to school families
- A short introductory video to share with parents & staff

*We recommend introducing this program to staff away from students. It is possible some staff members have their own stories of struggles or loss which you are not aware of. In case someone has an unexpected emotional response, this gives this person time to process this information before they have to share it with students. An emotional response is an acceptable reaction. And most parents who have experienced a life-threatening diagnosis or suffered a loss appreciate the opportunity to share their child's story with others. You never know what kind of team building could occur as a result of allowing others to share.

5. Educate your student body on the mission of Catherine Cares & *Bucks for Bears*.

Before your event, educate your student body on the mission of Catherine Cares, Bucks for Bears and your fundraising event. Use the same Student Video you showed your student leaders so every student is receiving the same message. The video is found online:

7. Optional: Apply for our Bucks for Bears grant online.

Deadline: Submissions due by Friday, April 6, 2018

Student leaders showcase their caring H.E.A.R.T.s used throughout the *Bucks for Bears* experience. Students will choose from 3 options:

- Produce a 3 minute or less video
- Write a 500 words or less essay
- Create a community art project with written intrepretation-300 words or less

Entries will be judged by the criteria outlined in *H.E.A.R.T.* Specifically, Catherine Cares would like your submission to showcase your school's *H.E.A.R.T.* by answering the following questions:

H - Healing

E - Empathy

A - Action

R - Raising Awareness

T - Teamwork

- What fundraising event did you implement to raise funds for Bucks for Bears? (Action, Raising Awareness, & Teamwork)
- How did you decide on that specific event? (Action, Raising Awareness & Teamwork)
- What impact do you think your event had on families? (Healing & Empathy)
- How did participating in Bucks for Bears impact you/make you feel? (Healing & Empathy)

In late April 2018, a letter will be sent to every participating school informing them of the outcome of the grant process. The winning school will receive a grant check for \$250. Arrangements to deliver a round of Heartbeat Bears to one of Catherine Cares' hospital partners will be made between school staff, the *Bucks for Bears* committee and hospital personnel.

All schools participating in *Bucks for Bears* will be recognized with a certificate of Thanks.
